The presentation description must be 350 words or less and submitted in MS Word using the attached Presentation Abstract Submittal Form. Abstracts should be submitted via email to the Speaker Committee Chairs – Arielle Poulos at [Arielle@turrell-associates.com](mailto:Arielle@turrell-associates.com). The 2016 Annual Conference Committee will review and vote on all abstract submissions. A notification of acceptance will be emailed to the corresponding author no later than **June 24, 2016**.
